Comments: 1. The Technical Services Administrator of the City of Knoxville Engineering Department has proposed

changing the street name of Richard Street because a partial street closure (2-C-24-SC) has resulted in disconnected street segments having the same name. Approving the name change will address the

safety issue for the Knox County Emergency Communications District.

2. No occupiable buildings will be affected by this renaming, as described in the applicant's reason for

change.

3. All property owners adjacent to the subject street section were provided the opportunity to suggest a new street name. The name "Vivid Lights Street" was designated by the Addressing department as no other name was selected by majority vote. The Addressing department will manage the needed

readdressing for properties that have direct access to this segment.

4. Planning has received no objections to the renaming of this right-of-way.

5. The name change meets all requirements of the City of Knoxville's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23,

Article IV, Section 23-108.
