In mapping the various cemeteries of Knox County, KGIS's Keith Stump has relied upon information contained in records and maps of the Property Assessor, Knox Planning (formerly MPC), Register of Deeds and KGIS (for aerial orthophotography). He has also consulted other publicly-accessible information such as old historical USGS topographic maps, the Geographic Names database (GNIS), and various websites such as Find-A-Grave and KnoxCoTN.org.

In particular, Keith has relied upon the many invaluable resources of Mr. Robert McGinnis, a recognized historical authority, and dedicated archivist of both Knox County's and East Tennessee's cemeteries.

Keith has attempted to align the full list of cemeteries on the KGIS map to those identified by Mr. Robert McGinnis as part of his comprehensive inventory of cemeteries. In performing the map updates, the following resources have been utilized:

1. The Cemetery Record Survey ([McG Survey](#)) that Robert McGinnis provided to Knox Planning (formerly MPC) back in mid 80's.
2. the list of "Knox County Cemeteries" ([McG Web](#)) as compiled by Mr. McGinnis and published on the KnoxCoTN.org website.
3. the various cemetery books authored by Robert McGinnis and housed at the McClung Library. ([McG Book](#))
4. A Cemetery Map ([McG Map](#)) corresponding to the McG Survey (see *item 1 above*) provided to MPC and showing the labeled locations of the various cemeteries listed on the Survey. (Date of Map: estimated to be 1985). The map also contains several cemetery markings without a label.
5. Meetings and conversations with Mr. McGinnis (especially March 1, 2018 meeting at KGIS), wherein Mr. McGinnis identified several needed corrections to (and feedback about) KGIS's mapped locations.

From this effort, Keith has compiled a couple of lists related to the Knox County's Cemeteries:

- [KGIS Gazetteer: Cemeteries, Graveyards of Knoxville and Knox County TN](#). – a full list of cemeteries that have been **mapped** on KGIS, sorted by Name and/or Alias Name. This list will be updated from time to time to reflect the updated maps.

This list is not an exhaustive list of all cemeteries: it contains only those for which an exact, or approximate, geographic location has been derived. This list includes both active cemeteries and locations of "historical", no-longer-existing cemeteries.

This pdf also contains URL links that allow one to quickly "zoom" to the [KGIS Maps](#) interactive map location of each cemetery. (Note, however, that these .pdf links do not work with some iOS-based browsers).

As of 10/11/2024 approximately **530 cemeteries** in Knox County have been **mapped** on KGIS.

- [List of Knoxville, Knox County, TN Cemeteries](#). – This document contains a full listing of all recognized cemeteries (**both mapped and unmapped**) of Knoxville and Knox County, and **sorted by unique Survey Number** (see Section D-1 below for further information about the *Survey Number*).

As of 9/26/2023, 526 cemeteries are included on this list, 30+ of which have yet to be mapped by KGIS due to especial uncertainty regarding their exact, or near exact, locations. This list will be updated from time to time to reflect newly obtained information.

Note: In those cases where the correct Survey Number (as assigned by Mr. Robert McGinnis and used throughout his numerous books and) not known, Keith has taken the liberty of assigning a temporary unique number (in the 900s range) simply as a placeholder and point of reference.

As with any project of this nature, there are still several questions and unresolved differences between the KGIS inventory of cemeteries, and the historical / documented records or “on-the-ground” situation. **Keith has attempted to outline many of those unresolved items in the sections below.**

NOTE about the **Hyperlinks**: This .pdf contains many hyperlinks that provide direct access to KGIS’s interactive maps. However, some browsers, such as Apple’s Safari, may not support these hyperlinks.

A. UN-MAPPED CEMETERIES – These cemeteries can be found on Robert McGinnis’ [survey list](#), or in his books, but **Keith has yet to reasonably locate these on the KGIS map. Keith is looking for further help to pinpoint the location** (or former location) **of these cemeteries.**

McG Book says loc. in Sevier Yards of Old Rutledge Pike. At one time, w marked graves near what is called the Rip-Track. As of Apr 1979 all evidence gone. The McG Map shows a cemetery being at this location, but it is incorrectly labeled #78(which is a duplicate of the Chamberlain Cem #78 label on that same McG Map). Keith has no other sources of info of where that cemetery might formally be located. Exact XY is needed.
C	75	Cemetery (unknown)	No physical remains left	McG says located off Norris Frwy near intersection with Pelleaux Rd . Site plowed under and no physical remains left. McG Map shows it located near 8156 Pelleaux Rd .
F	151	Foust	Disappeared	Keith is not sure where this one might be located. It is a duplicated Survey Number Number (#151) with with Foster Chapel, and it also has a similar name as F460 (Louis Foust). Located off of Foust Hollow Rd. Keith assumes that this entry on the McG Survey List was entered incorrectly, and was later added as a new entry. Therefore, for information about this cemetery, see F460.
H	207	Haupt	Moved to Old Gray;	McG book says formerly located on Sixth Ave adj. to present Caswell Park. Graves were located in garden of the Haupt homestead, but moved to Old gray in 1895. John Haupt lived in his house till 1915. McG Map to MPC places it further west , at a location now underneath I40 . Exact Location needs verification.
O	319	Old Crestview (Black)	See Crestview. KGIS: <i>Where is this located in the Crestview Cemetery?</i>	Is this a particular section, or just an Alias of the existing Crestview cemetery?
R	347	Reed III	No visible evidence.	Keith is unable to determine approximate location of this cemetery. McGinnis not quite sure where located at 3/1/2018 meeting. McG book says located in a plowed over field betw/ Troutman Ln and Middlebrook Pike , one or two unmarked graves, but no evidence. McG Map to MPC places it near today’s 1614 Campfire Dr . There is another Reed Cemetery II nearby on Tatanka Ln (but which is called just Reed Cemetery on the USGS topo map).
S	378	Silver Moon		Is Silver Moon Lodge Cemetery another alias for Oddfellows Cemetery (O-313) and/or the Old Banner Lodge Cemetery (O-316)
W	433	Watson	Not found	McG Map to MPC places this on northern corner of parcel at 9509 Loyston Rd . It is on the property previously owned by the Clark family. Is the map perhaps incorrect? Is this location (9509 Loyston Rd) perhaps the correct location for Clark Cem (see #C88 above)? Otherwise, Keith has no other information on where this cemetery might have been located.
C	455	Cemetery (unknown)		McG Web says on Childress Rd. McG Map to MPC places this near current address 2009 Scenic Meadow Way . Exact Location needed.
C	456	Cemetery (unknown)	Cholera epidemic; Approx 6 graves	McG 2001 Book says on Old Weisgarber. Near int. w Weisg, on a hill above Weigels. Nicely property. Possibly 1216 Old Weisgarber Rd ?? McG Map seems to place it closer to 6325 Ridgerock Rd .

C	457	Cemetery (unknown)	Apprx. 4 graves	Keith is unable to determine approximate location of this cemetery. McG South book says loc. Off of White Frye Ln and at top of bluff overlooking Ft. Loudon Lake. McG Map to MPC also shows it near 2325 White Frye Ln
G	459	George Clapp		McG Book 2000 says no current evidence of grave (and also refers to this cemetery as number C457). McG Survey and Map to MPC notes this cemetery instead as #C459 and shows this on small ridge behind 8816 Sunrise Rd. , but McG book says it was located on McAnally Ridge (which is the bigger ridge to the north). Exact location is needed. Further note: The Lowe Cemetery (#L251) is also located along this same small ridge according to the McG Map to MPC.
F	460	Louis Foust	At 3/1/2018 meeting, McG said this one is Gone	Duplicated Name with McG F151 (Foust); McG Book 2000 refers to this as Louis Foust F460, and says that most stones removed in mid 70s. McG Map to MPC has this located in proximity of 8312 Foust Hollow Rd. Keith unsure of exact location.
C	461	Chumlea		McG Book 2001 says "Was Located". Was this Possibly near 3614 Tracy Way ? McG book 2001 says about 50 ft. from old house in 1987, 100 yr S of Grace Baptist, off of old Beaver Ridge Rd and 100 ft W of the road. However, the book also says that between 1987 and 2001 a s/d was built, which leads one to think that the cemetery may have been located somewhere near the Stoneridge S/D, which is east of current Grace Baptist. The McG Map to MPC actually places this cem in vicinity of 7241 Oak Ridge Hwy. Verification needed as to exact location. Note: McG Web and McG Survey says street name of "Old Ball Camp Pike"
S	462	Cemetery (Slave)		McG Book has this as #S462, but Keith thinks that it is likely a typo (since there is already a #C462 cemetery (Maxwell Cemetery) that is listed in the McG Survey and located in a different part of the County...off of Millertown Pike. Is this #S462 cemetery instead meant to refer to the #M262 (Maxwell Cemetery)? In fact, the McG Web site lists the M262 Maxwell Cem with a tag of "Black/Slave". McG 2001 Book says this slave cemetery is loc off Northshore Dr about 100 yds N of Maxwell Cemetery (M-262). Therefore, is this a separate, perhaps non-contiguous, extension of the M462? McG book says that there were about 15 cstones in 1984. Was this slave cemetery perhaps in vicinity of 1709 Bickerstaff Blvd?
C	463	Cemetery (unknown) Chesterfield		Survey entry not found on Web listing. McG Map to MPC has this located on sw portion of parcel 032 068 (Owner: Nicely), sw of Mine Rd / Old Rutdege intersection).
L	466	Lovelace	No longer visible	At 3/1/2018 meeting with McG, Keith obtained an XY (Click Here) that doesn't seem to match with McG's book description of it having been 100 feet NORTH of McCammon in a fence row. McG Map to MPC also bears this out too, and seems to instead place this cemetery somewhere near 1639 McCammon Rd. Therefore, Keith needs confirmation on the location.
C	468	Cemetery (unknown)	Disappeared	Survey entry not found on Web. Keith does not know where this might have been located. Loc on Kim Watt Dr. McG Map to MPC does not display a 468 in the vicinity of Kim Watt Rd. However, C509 is in the vicinity, but not labeled on the map. Could perhaps C468 be the same cemetery as C509?
C	470	Cemetery (unknown)		Survey entry says located on Baum Dr, but cemetery not found on the Web listing, nor in McG books. McG Map to MPC shows it being located in vicinity of parcel at 6431 Baum Dr. Exact location is needed, along with status. Also, is this perhaps the same cemetery as #M493 James Miller Cemetery?
C	479	Cemetery (unknown)		Keith is unable to determine approximate location of this cemetery. The McG Web listing says this was on Clear Springs Rd, with date range of 1865-1880. The McG Map to MPC contains an unlabeled cemetery in vicinity of 3000 Clear Springs Rd. Exact Location and name is needed.
T	494	Tipton Cemetery	Destroyed	McG Book 2001 also called "Old Slave Graveyard" on Cagle Farm near Maryville Pike and Tipton Station intersection. Keith is unsure where this might have been.
C	498	Cemetery (unknown)	Now Lost	McG 2000 book says it was near barn behind Baptist Group Home for Boys. Keith not quite sure where that group home might have been. The "Millertown Group Home" was recently operated at 5713 Millertown Pike, at which location there is now a Church of Christ. However, Keith doesn't have any evidence to this having been a "Baptist" group home. Note: another Unnamed cemetery #462 is located nearby (see USGS maps and KGIS). Are these one and the same?
C	501	Casteel Station Cemetery	Unknown Location	Not found on McG Sur or Web; Book says that graves were located s of river somewhere betw John Sevier Hwy and Hodges Ferry on Casteel Family land. Keith not able to reasonably guess at the location. However, the McG map to MPC does contain a small unlabeled (#3) dot in vicinity of Hodges Ferry Rd.
C	502	Cemetery (unknown) / Fort Stanley	Lost	McG 2001 book says this was previously on land of the College Park Apt Complex; Was it possibly located near 301 Lippencott St #1311 ? (see UnLabeled #4 in Sect B)
S	508	Slave Cemetery	S454	At 3/1/2018 meeting, McG indicated that he thinks this is the same cemetery as S454 (on the Dowell Lonas Farm). Keith to get confirmation.
C	509	Confederate Cemetery	?	McG Web and Survey do not have this cemetery; McG Book 2001 says location is SECRET (private Georgia soldiers died at private home hospital near Third Creek, graves not marked. Could this be the Middlebrook House ? The McG Map to MPC contains an unlabeled black mark at this location. Note: the McG Survey List to MPC

				does contains a "Cemetery (unknown)" (#C468) as having disappeared but having been located on Kim Watt Rd, which is near Middlebrook House, but there is not an accompanying #468 label on the map itself. Is perhaps #468 the same as this #509? Verification needed regarding both C509 and C468.
H	510	Hendrix Cemetery	?	McG Web and Survey do not have this cemetery; in Solway. Keith unable to locate a guess. There is an unlabeled cemetery (see unlabeled #5 in Section B) on McG Map near 2704 Hawk Haven Ln ...could this be the location of Hendrix Cemetery?
		Gallows Hill		This McG Web record is NOT in the McG Survey, but McG 2017 book says it was across from Immaculate Conception, KGIS Guess....perhaps near 415 W Vine Ave ? NOTE: Keith has assigned this graveyard the temporary survey number of #925.
		Marble Hill Cemetery	Relocated in 1980 to Marble Hill Church of God Cemetery	McG Book 2003 makes reference to this graveyard, which was relocated in 1980 to Marble Hill Church of God Cem. Keith has mapped this as being at the unnamed cemetery location (approx.. 2500 Riverside Dr) indicated on the 1953 USGS Quad map. Verification needed to confirm that Marble Hill Cem was the same one indicated on that USGS map.
		Ridgeway Baptist		McG Web Listing notes that this cemetery is located along Lacy Road. However, Keith assumes that this cemetery name (as spelled on the McG Web listing) should instead have stated "Ridgeview Baptist Church Cemetery", which is located along Lacy Rd. It is Keith's understanding that <i>Ridgeway Baptist</i> is actually located on Kimberlin Heights Rd in south Knox County, and is the current name for the <i>Ridgeway Methodist Cemetery</i> . Clarification needed.
		Unnamed Cemetery (Black)	Disappeared	McG East TN Cemeteries Facebook post of 12/7/2018 notes that Knox's old African-American cemetery would have been located near the Ruth Chris Steak house. Keith unsure of what name (or number) this burial ground might have had.
		Wadel (Wadell) Family Cemetery		Book by Charles Edwin Price (Mysterious Knoxville), 1999, makes reference to this cemetery being located in Knox County between Knoxville and Maryville, in a little clump of trees about a quarter mile off State route 129. fell into ruin, and only a little of it can be seen today (1999), with a few markers lying hidden in underbrush. Robert McGinnis in phone call of 1/1/2019 confirmed that the cemetery now gone. He recalls it being in vicinity of Topside Rd.

B. Questions about Cemeteries on McGinnis' Map to MPC.

Robert McGinnis provided MPC (the organization which is now called Knox Planning) with a "marked up" county-wide map ([McG Map](#)) in the mid 1980's, on which he had identified the general location of every cemetery in Knox County, along with each cemetery's unique Survey # label (as listed on the accompanying [Survey List](#) to MPC). Keith, after comparing Mr. McGinnis' "marked up" map with KGIS's mapped cemetery locations, has identified several questions.

Why are there two separate locations for this grave on the map?	3003 Sanders Dr. which is the KGIS approx. location of the McG Map marking
B	28	Berry Cemetery (historical)	The McG map places this cemetery to the south of Berry Rd near 2110 Berry Rd , and therefore at a distance of approx. 1000 ft from the XY coordinates (off of Mt. Olive Rd) provided to Keith by McG at the meeting of 3/1/2018.	KGIS has mapped this at 1936 Mt. Olive Rd based upon XY provided by McG at 3/1/2018 meeting.
B	29	Bethany Baptist	McG Map location of this cemetery should be moved further to the SW.	
B	48	Bradley – Dowell	McG Map to MPC does not show #48 anywhere. However an unlabeled cemetery marking is shown on that map to the west of Dry Gap Pike (whereas the Bradley – Dowell Cemetery location on KGIS (as confirmed by McG at 3/1/2018 meeting) is to the east of Dry Gap Pike. Keith assumes map is not correct.	KGIS Location: 7119 Mash Ln.

B	57	Browns Gap Baptist	McG Map has this located along Bob Varner Rd, but it should instead be located along McFall Ln; Location on the map also needs to be flip-flopped with Varner (426)	
B	58	Burnett Cemetery	McG Map location for this is at same location of KGIS's mapped Joseph Bell Cemetery (KGIS #912).	
	78	Duplicate Labeled Cemetery (#78)	McG Map has duplicate #78 labels: one is the Chamberlain – Little Cemetery on Circle Rd near House Mtn, which is probably the correct one; the other #78 cemetery label is located NE of the Sevier Rail Yards . (sw of the Rising Rd\Old Rutledge Pike intersection). It's likely that this should have been instead been labeled on the McG Map as #72. (see above Section A)	7505 Old Rutledge Pike
C	88	Clark (historical)	McG Map places this cemetery approx. 1.5 straight line miles to the west of where McG and KGIS jointly placed the cemetery at their 3/1/2018 meeting (off of Loyston Rd). McG map location also doesn't align with the McG Survey that says "New Loyston Rd". Keith could find no information about Clark Cemetery in the McG books. McG confirmed that cemetery no longer visible.	KGIS Location: 9202 Old Maynardville Pike
C	90	Clear Springs Baptist	McG Map seems to have this in the wrong location (near Edwards Place Blvd & Thompson School Rd intersection).	KGIS Location: 8520 Thompson School Rd
	102	???	There seems to be a label #102 located on McG map at corner of Grand Ave and Sixteenth St, but this mismatches with the other #102 label at Bethel Civil Cem. Not sure whether this label is incorrect on map or not.	1608 Grand Ave

C	110	Moses Cox	McG Map places has this cemetery as being located about 1 mile to the north of the XY location provided by McG at the 3/1/2018 meeting at KGIS.	KGIS Location: 7720 Maynardville Pike ; McG Map location: 7904 Maynardville Pike .
C	111	Curd Cox	McG Map places this at a considerably different location than the one identified by McG during the 3/1/2018 meeting.	KGIS Location: 736 E Bullrun Valley Dr
C	112	Corum (historical)	McG Map places this near 1811 Pinestraw Ln; however description at https://www.wikitree.com/wiki/Corum-64 places this cemetery most likely on parcel at 1908 Lovell Rd (which is on the opposite side of Lovell Rd)	KGIS Location: 1908 Lovell Rd ; McG Map Location: 1811 Pinestraw Ln
E	134	Early	McG Map location is about ½ mile further south of the marina, which is where USGS maps this cemetery.	KGIS/USGS Location: 12245 Choto Marina Way
F	148	Forestdale	McG Map location seems to be couple of blocks east of the 2003 book description (which places this cemetery along Brunswick St). Keith assumes Brunswick St location is correct.	KGIS: 3118 Brunswick St
F	150	Foster	McG Map places this cemetery about 1400 feet further upstream along Flat Creek than the Foster Cem location on the USGS map. Keith tentatively placed this cem. at the USGS location	KGIS Location

G	165	Goddard	McG Map to MPC shows this cemetery in a considerably different location (about 2 miles away) from that which was id'ed by McG at the 3/1/2018 meeting at KGIS. The McG map positions this cemetery to the north of Goddard Mtn (near Roddy Branch).	KGIS Location: 2407 Stock Creek Rd
H	179	Hall III (Obadiah)	McG Map location does not look to be correct. McG should have located it further to the SW.	
H	186	Haun	McG Map shows this as being located along McCammon Rd but approx. 1.5 miles to the east of Tarwater Cem (#399). However, on 12/28/2023 McG confirmed that Haun Cem (#186) and Jacob Tarwater (#399) are actually one and the same cemetery. Therefore, the original McG 1985 map was incorrect. RESOLVED.	Original McG Map location: near 1118 McCammon Rd ; current location as confirmed by McG on 12/28/2023: 8418 Bud King Ln
K	227	Keyhill – Kirby	McG Map to MPC does not specifically identify this cemetery (#227). However, there is a light-blue smudge on the map in the vicinity of this cemetery.

L	253	Luttrell II	McG Map shows this about 1.5 west of where KGIS has located (based upon XY provided by McG 3/1/2018 meeting).	KGIS Location: 8455 Strawberry Plains Pike
M	270	McCall II	McG Map to MPC shows McCall as having been located on the north side of Cabbage Rd (near 4323 Cabbage Dr), about 2000 feet away from the XY location provided by McG at the 3/1/2018 meeting.	KGIS Location: 4215 Kingdom Ln
M	281	Meadowlawn	McG Map to MPC seems to have this cemetery (#281) mis-labeled as #290 (Mountain View), and vice-versa.	KGIS Location: on Wise Springs Rd
M	290	Mountain View	McG Map to MPC seems to have this cemetery (#290) mis-labeled as #281 (Mountain View).	KGIS Location: via Maloneyville Pike

O	323	Old Packett	McG Map shows this as being near 502 Burris Rd , which is about 2000 feet from KGIS's location of this cemetery (which Keith assumes is also called Sherrod – Burris). Need verification of name / aliases, along with verification of correct location	KGIS Location: 8517 Pleasant Hill Rd
R	348	Reynolds (historical)	McG Map shows this cemetery located approx. 1200 feet to the NE (near 6016 Brookvale Ln) from where KGIS has estimated that it was located.	KGIS Location: 140 Major Reynolds Pl
R	349	Rhea	McG Map to MPC incorrectly labels this cemetery with #348 (which is duplicated number with Reynolds Cemetery). The label should have been 349	
S	362	Saylor (historical)	McG Map to MPC has this located along "Saylor Ford Rd", but current MPC map calls this segment "Fishtrap n". Not sure whether the old map was in error or not.	KGIS Location: 1305 Fishtrap Ln
S	365	Sellers	McG Map to MPC has this located about 3 miles away (near Doane Lane) from the location that McG provided to KGIS at the 3/2018 meeting. Therefore, verification of exact location is definitely needed.	KGIS Location: near 824 Midway Rd

S	378	Silver Moon Lodge	McG Map does not have this label on the map, but Keith assumes it is an alias to #0313 Odd Fellows Cem	
S	375	Shipe Cemetery III	McG Map shows this cemetery located in vicinity of 3913 Shipe Rd , but USGS quad map shows Shipe Cem as being approx. 2000 feet further south along Shipe Rd towards Millertown Pike.	KGIS Location: near 3333 Shipe Rd
S	386	Spangler	McG Map shows this much further (~1.3 miles) south (near 8943 Henry Hollow Way) of the location that was provided at the 3/1/2018 meeting (which is adjacent to what looks to be an old log home). Therefore, Keith has T398 a further 2 miles to the SW. Keith has added a new cemetery (see Valley View Missionary Baptist Church Cemetery) at 912 Tarklin Valley Rd location. T	399	Jacob Tarwater	McG Map seems to place this cemetery (near 8415 Bud King Rd). However, 2006 deed (200612050046896) places this cemetery on parcel at 8418 Bud King. Not visible on Aerial.	KGIS Location: 8418 Bud King Rd
T	401	Tecoy Cemetery	McG Map does not have a label of #401 anywhere near the location of this cemetery.	KGIS Location: 6563 Oak Ridge Hwy

D. Further Questions:

- 1. SURVEY NUMBERS.** Mr. Robert McGinnis has developed a unique numbering system for each of the cemeteries compiled by him during his many years of research. This unique number can be very useful for researchers, especially considering that cemetery names can change / vary over the years. And since there are several "unnamed" cemeteries, the unique *survey* number is perhaps the best available identifier.

Therefore, using the resources on hand, Keith has attempted to match each of the KGIS-mapped cemeteries to the appropriate survey # (as assigned / compiled by McGinnis). Keith's research found that the *survey numbers* (as compiled by Mr. Robert McGinnis) range from #1 (John Adair Cemetery) up to #532 (for the Grills Family Cemetery).

However, in his compiled list of *survey numbers*, Keith recognized that **several gaps**: numbers to which a cemetery name has not been associated.

Gaps: #'s 476-478, 480-488, 492, 497, 503, 513-531

It is Keith's assumption that Mr. McGinnis, as part of his ongoing research, has already assigned each of these "missing" *survey numbers* to a cemetery. Keith will consult with Mr. McGinnis to discern whether there is an updated list of unique identifiers to help fill in the gaps.

Keith also asks the question of whether there might perhaps be **additional Knox County cemeteries with survey #'s greater than #532?**

2. NAMED CEMETERIES NOT having an ASSIGNED SURVEY NUMBER. The following list contains named cemeteries by KGIS or by Mr. McGinnis but without an assigned Survey #. Again, it is very likely that Mr. McGinnis has assigned a unique survey number to several of these (see D.1 above regarding "gaps" in the survey numbers).

To foster the record-keeping on the above cemeteries (for which a unique *Survey Number* is not known), Keith has assigned a temporary unique number (in the 900s range) simply as a placeholder and point of reference. 3. NAMES and ALIASES. Keith has identified several questions concerning the names of various Knox County cemeteries. Keith seeks help in identifying the valid names and / or aliases:

Note: In reference to the cemetery names as mapped on the KGIS system, Keith uses the convention of appending the text “ (historical)” to the names of those cemeteries presumed to no longer exist.

A-2. Adams Cemetery. Should this be *Adams* or *Adam*? ([LINK](#))

A-3. Anderson – Ford Cemetery. Keith has found varying names for this. Is *Anderson – Ford* correct?

A-9. Aultom Cemetery. Find-A-Grave calls this one *Aulton*. Is *Aulton* a valid alias?

B-10. Bair Cemetery. For some reason , MPC’s database has a site name of [Burris Cemetery](#) at this location.

However, McG doesn’t seem to mention *Burris*. USGS says *Bair*. Is *Burris* a valid alias for this cemetery? (Note: there is another, different cemetery (O-323) that is called *Burris Cemetery* by the Property Assessor, but which is called [Sherrod Cemetery](#) by USGS and *Old Packett* by McGinnis).

B-11. Baker – White Cemetery. Keith has found conflicting names. Property Assessor records make reference to a [James Cemetery](#) at this location. McG also calls this *Baker II (White)*. What is the best assigned name, and what are its valid aliases?

B-15. Barnard Cemetery. Some web resources (knoxco,tn, Tennessee Gazetteer, etc.) also show this as *Barner Cemetery*. Property Assessor calls this *Emory Pike American Christian Church Cemetery*. Which is the correct name, and which names are valid aliases?

B-32. Bethel Methodist Cemetery. KGIS has this as *Lynch Bethel*. What is the proper primary name, and valid aliases? Should it be *Lynch – Bethel* (i.e. with a hyphen)?

B-33. Bethlehem Sunrise Cemetery. Keith has also seen this cemetery listed as *Bethlehem Methodist*. What is the proper name, and aliases? Should it have a hyphen?

B-36. Bird Cemetery. Keith has seen this listed as *Bird Cemetery* and also as *Bird – Dunn Cemetery*. Which is the correct name, and which is a valid alias?

B-39. Blaine’s Chapel Cemetery. Should this be *Blaine’s Chapel* or *Blaine Chapel*? Church sign out front , and USGS, says *Blaine Chapel*.

B-40. Booker – Hill Cemetery. USGS and Property Assessor call this *Bradley Cemetery*, while McG seems to refer to this as *Booker – Hill*. Which name is correct, or are both correct? McG also has a cemetery called *Bradley – Dowell (B-48)*.

B-57. Brown’s Gap Baptist Cemetery. USGS calls it *Brown Gap*. KGIS also has this as *Brown Gap Church Cemetery*. What is the best name?

B-58. Burnett Cemetery. Find a Grave also refers to this as *Burnett – Lusby Cemetery*. Is this a valid alias for this cemetery?

C-65. Campbell – McNutt Cemetery. USGS calls this *Campbell Cemetery*. What is the proper name, and what are the valid aliases.

C-67. Carter II Cemetery. The Saving Graves website calls this *Carters Mill Cemetery*. Is it perhaps better called *Carter Mill Cemetery* (i.e. without the ‘s)? What is the proper name, and what are valid aliases?

C-86. Claiborne Cemetery. Keith has seen two different spellings of this: *Claiborne* and *Clairborne*. Which is correct?

- C-89 and C-90 Clear Springs Baptist Cemetery. There are two different cemeteries, each of which has the same name as the other. Should one of these be classified as *Clear Springs II*? Keith has labeled these respectively as *Clear Springs Mascot Cemetery* and *Clear Spring Corryton Cemetery*? Is there perhaps a better way to distinguish between these two different cemeteries?
- C-91. Clift Cemetery. There are varying spellings of this cemetery. USGS and McG book says *Clift*, but McG Survey and McG Web says *Cliff*. What is the correct name?
- C-93. Cobb Cemetery. There are some variants in the name. USGS calls this *Cobbs Cemetery*. McG calls it *Cobb*. Since there is also a *Cobb II* and a *Cobb III*, Keith presumes that this cemetery is called *Cobb*. Please confirm whether correct spelling should be *Cobb* or *Cobbs*?
- C-104. Copper Ridge Methodist Cemetery. The property assessor only shows *Copper Ridge Baptist*. What is the proper name of this cemetery, and which is a valid alias.?
- C-117 Crestview Cemetery / L-248. Longview Cemetery. Knox Heritage map does not quite align with City Ward map designation of Longview and Crestview extents. Confirm accuracy of Knox Heritage map: <http://knoxheritage.org/west-view-historic-cemetery-district/>
- C-119. Martin Cruze Cemetery. Conflicting names: McG Book says *James Madison Cruze*; McG survey says *Martin Cruze*. What is the correct name?
- D-123. Dailey Cemetery. McG 2001 book also gives an alias of *Stoney Point Cemetery*; MPC Street Name and USGS says *Stony Point*. Assessor Owner records, along with McG FB post of 2/5/2023 in East TN Cemeteries, call this *Stoney*. What is the proper spelling for the alias? [Note: McG and USGS both refer to this cemetery as “Dailey” as the primary name.]
- E-136. East Hill Avenue Methodist Church Cemetery. Sanborn Map of 1890 shows this cemetery being located slightly to the west of the location identified by McG. Google E-book of *The Modern Cemetery* magazine refers to this as “Old Methodist Hill” cemetery. Did perhaps the Old Methodist Cemetery get moved (in the early 20th century) several hundred feet east to the vicinity of the Hotel Knoxville (formerly Hyatt Regency)?
- E-137. Eastport Cemetery. Need confirmation as to whether both portions of this cemetery (on the northern and southern sides of Addison St) are called Eastport, or whether one/both of them are better known as “Good Citizens” Cemetery (or “Citizens” Cemetery).
- E-142. Eubanks Chapel Christian Cemetery. Keith obtained an alternative name for this cemetery (from an unknown source) of *Whitaker Family Cemetery*. Is this a valid alternative name (alias) for this cemetery?
- F-151. Foust Cemetery. On the McG Web and Survey list, *Foust Cemetery* was shown as having disappeared and with a survey #151. However, there is another cemetery *Foster Chapel Cemetery* with that same #151. Furthermore, there is a (*Louis*) *Foust Cemetery* assigned #460. Are there two separate Foust cemeteries? If so, what are their respectively correct survey #? And for both, the exact XY location, extents and status is needed. Note: Keith assumes that #460 is the correct entry for *Foust*, and that the McG Survey List *F-151* was a typo.
- F-154. Fraker Cemetery. Property Assessor and MPC (and subdivision plat) all seem to refer to this cemetery as *Graves Cemetery*. Is *Graves* a valid alias, or was it perhaps typed in as a generic synonym for *cemetery*?
- F-155. Furewell Cemetery. What is the correct name? USGS says *Hall Cemetery*; McG says *Furewell*.
- G-158. Garrett Cemetery. McG’s Survey (to MPC) seems to spell this cemetery as *Garnett*, however McG’s book and web resources spell it as *Garrett*. Keith is assuming that the correct name is *Garrett*.
- G-161. Perry - Gibbs Cemetery. MPC’s assigned site name calls this just *Gibbs*. Which name is the commonly used name, and which is an alias?
- G-170. Graves Cemetery. Find a Grave references this as *Boston Graves*. Is that a valid alias?
- G-172. Greenfield Memory Gardens. News Sentinel article referred to this as the *Fort Sumter Community Cemetery*. Keith is assuming that *Greenfield Memory Gardens* and *Halls Memory Gardens* are historical names that are no longer being used today. Can you verify the current name being used?
- G-174. Grigsby Chapel Methodist. Keith has found two different spellings: *Grigsby* and *Grisby*. Which is correct? And is the other a valid alias?
- G-175. Groves Cemetery. Keith has seen several alterations of this name. Property Assessor and MPC refer to it as *Grove Cemetery*. Other sources call it *Grove – Graves* or *Groves*. Which is the correct spelling?
- G-176. Grubbs Cemetery. Is the proper spelling *Grubbs* or *Grubb*?

- H-187. Haynes Cemetery. Find a Grave refers to this as *Haynes – Rule*. Is that a valid alias to *Haynes*?
- H-189 Heska – Amuna Cemetery. Is *New Jewish Cemetery* also a valid alias, and perhaps a more commonly used reference for this cemetery?
- H-198. Holloway Cemetery. Keith found that Find a Grave refers to this as *Holliway*. However, Keith assumes that Find A Grave is incorrect. Is *Holliway* a valid alias?
- H-205. Huckleberry Methodist Cemetery. Should this name be *Huckleberry Springs Methodist Cemetery*?
- I-208. Ingram Cemetery. Keith calls this *Franse – Ingram Cemetery* based upon USGS, Find a Grave, and Geocaching web site names. Which is the most legit name, and which is the more commonly used name?
- K-226. Kenner Cemetery. McG Web and Survey spell this as *Keener*, but McG Book spells it *Kenner*. Which is correct?
- K-230. Knoxville College Cemetery. Is *Freedmans Mission Cemetery* a valid alias? Or *Freedmens?* or *Fourth United Presbyterian?* Which are valid aliases?
- L-234. Latham Cemetery. Keith seems to remember reading somewhere that this cemetery (which seems to have disappeared) might also be the same as *Fletcher Cemetery* (#F147). However, since the McG Map to MPC had *Fletcher Cemetery* located elsewhere, Keith decided not to tag *Fletcher* as an alias name with this *Latham* cemetery. Facebook post of 3/7/2021 by McG says an alias of Latham Cemetery is *Union Zion*.
- L-240. Legg – England Cemetery. USGS and Find a Grave calls this *England – Legg*. Which is the most proper order?
- L-250. Looney Cemetery. the Property Assessor and Find a Grave call this *Lones Cemetery*. Is that a valid alias?
- L-244. Lonas II Cemetery. There seems to be some varying spellings. Therefore, Keith is unsure of which is most correct, and which are valid aliases: *Lonas II Cemetery*; *Charles Lonas Cemetery*; *Lones Family Cemetery*; *Lones – Dowell Cemetery*?
- M-263. May Cemetery. MPC and Property Assessor call this *Murray Cemetery*. Find A Grave and McG call it *May Cemetery*. Which is the primary name, and which is the alias?
- M-265. McBath Cemetery. Varying names... Find a Grave and McG call this *McBath*; Property Assessor and MPC call it *Pennell*; USGS calls it *Childs*. Which of these is the primary, and which of the others are valid aliases?
- M-290. Mountainview Cemetery. McG's web list also calls this (*Pauper*). However, there is also an adjacent cemetery O-324 called *Old Poor Farm Cemetery*. Is *Pauper* considered an alias to only the *Mountainview* section or to both cemeteries? Also, is the proper spelling *Meadowview* (one word) or *Meadow View* (two words)?
- M-292, M-293. Mt. Harmony Baptist. These two cemeteries have duplicate names. Is one of the two condiered to be *Mt. Harmony I* and the other perhaps *Mt. Harmony II*? Or is there perhaps a commonly used name that helps to distinguish between the two...for instance, *Mt. Harmony (Heiskell)*?
- N-305. Neubert Cemetery. The Property Assessor deed makes note that this cemetery is associated with the *Tipton Station Rd Church of Christ*. Is that also a valid alias for this cemetery?
- O-312. Oakland Cemetery. Is the common name for this *Oakland Cemetery* or *Oakland Community Cemetery*?
- O-313. Oddfellows Cemetery. Is the proper spelling of this one word or two words: *Oddfellows* vs. *Odd Fellows*?
- O-316. Old Banner Oddfellows Cemetery. Is this just an alias to both O-313 *Oddfellows Cemetery* and S-378 *Silver Moon Cemetery*? Or is it a completely different section/location from those cemeteries?
- O-316. Old Banner Oddfellows Cemetery. Is *Old Banner Lodge Cemetery* a valid alias for this cemetery?
- O-323. Old Packett Cemetery. USGS calls this *Sherrod Cemetery*, whereas Property Assessor and MPC call it *Burriss Cemetery*; Keith has labeled it as *Sherrod – Burriss*. Which is the most proper name, and which are valid aliases? Note: the MPC Map to MPC shows *Old Packett* being in a location different (about 2000 feet east) from USGS's *Sherrod*. Confirmation on whether these cemeteries are one and the same is needed.
- O-324. Old Poor Farm Cemetery. Keith has given this one an alias of *County Pauper Cemetery*? Is that a valid alias? [Also see M-290 above].
- P-338. Piney Grove Baptist Cemetery. The Geographic Names database (GNIS) also references an alias of *Amherst Church* to this. Is *Amherst Church Cemetery* a valid alias?
- P-344. Pratts Chapel Baptist Cemetery. USGS calls this *Pratt Chapel*, but McG and Property Assessor call it *Pratts Chapel*. Find a Grave calls it *Pratt Cemetery*. Which is the proper spelling, and which are valid aliases?
- R-351. Ridgeway Methodist Cemetery. Is *Ridgeway Baptist Cemetery* also a valid alias for this cemetery?

- R-355. Rogers Cemetery. MPC and Property Assessor call this one *Rodgers Cemetery*. USGS, Find a Grave and McG call this *Rogers*. Which is the correct spelling?
- S-367. Shady Grove Baptist Cemetery. Keith obtained an alias of *Possum Valley Cemetery* from a source that he is unable to recall. Is *Possum Valley Cemetery* a valid alias for this cemetery?
- S-369. Shell Cemetery. Is *Old Fairview Baptist Church Cemetery* a valid alias for this cemetery? (again Keith can't recall from which source he obtained this name).
- S-374. Shipe II Cemetery. Property Assessor and MPC refer to this as *Bethlehem United Methodist Church Cemetery*. Is this a valid alias for *Shipe II Cemetery*?
- S-378. Silver Moon Cemetery. Keith has assumed that *Silver Moon Lodge Cemetery* is another alias for *Oddfellows Cemetery (O-313)* and for the *Old Banner Lodge Cemetery (O-316)*? Is that correct?
- S-379, S-380, S-381. Slave Cemetery. There are several surveyed graves with the generic name of *Slave Cemetery*. Are there perhaps a numbering of these (*I, II, III, etc.*) that would make them uniquely identified in a place name search?
- S-382. Smithwood Baptist Cemetery. Is *Adair Creek Baptist Church Cemetery* (obtained from Churches-Cemeteries.Com) a valid alias for this cemetery?
- S-384. Solway Church of God Cemetery. USGS also has a reference to *Providence Church* having been located here. Is *Providence Church Cemetery* a valid alias?
- S-389. Stair Cemetery. Keith inferred that the name of the un-named cemetery on the USGS map is McG's *Stair Cemetery*. Is this a correct assumption?
- T-399. Jacob Tarwater Cemetery. Is this the same cemetery as referred to by Find-A-Grave and Ancestry.Com as *Hahn – Tarwater Cemetery*? If so, is *Hahn – Tarwater* a valid alias? Should it be spelled *Haun – Tarwater*? (note: McG verified on 12/28/2023 that Haun Cem (#186) is actually the same cemetery as this one.)
- T-401. Tekoa Baptist Cemetery. Keith has seen several different spellings for this cemetery: *Tekoa Baptist, Tekoa Union Baptist, Teacoy, Tecoy, Tecoy Baptist*. Which of these is most valid, and what are the valid aliases?
- T-408. Tillery Cemetery. USGS calls this former cemetery *Callahan Cemetery*. Do both of these names apply to this same, former cemetery location? Facebook posts of 8/20/2018 seem to confirm that these are one and the same cemetery.
- T-412. Tipton Station Church of Christ Cemetery. The N-305 *Neubert Cemetery* is also referred to as the *Tipton Station Church of Christ Cemetery* according to MPC and Property Assessor records. Were both of these cemeteries (T-412 and N-305) associated with the same church? Is perhaps one of these considered to be *Tipton Station I* and the other *Tipton Station II*? Keith needs some verification regarding correct names and aliases for these two cemeteries.
- T-414. Trout Cemetery. MPC calls this one *Trout Cemetery*. Which spelling is most legit, and is the other a valid alias?
- T-417. Twinville Methodist Cemetery. Is *Twinville Baptist Church Cemetery* a valid alias for this cemetery?
- T-425. Van Loon Cemetery. Keith has obtained an alias to this cemetery as *Taggart Cemetery*. (However, he is unsure of the source for that alias name). Is *Taggart Cemetery* a valid alias?
- V-427. Vestal Methodist Cemetery. McG also has a separate *Maxey Cemetery (#M-453)* that might be at this same location. Is *Maxey Cemetery* an alias for this cemetery?
- W-443. Woods II Cemetery. McG 2017 book calls this *Wood Cemeter*, but McG Survey and McG Web call this *Woods*. Which name is most correct, and is the other a valid alias?
- Z-447. Zachary Cemetery. MPC Site Name records referenced this cemetery as being called *Tillett Cemetery*. Is *Tillett* a valid alias for this cemetery?
- Z-450. Zion Lutheran Cemetery. Keith has seen reference to a *Giezentanner* on McG's web listing. Is this a valid alias? And if so, what is the correct spelling: *Giezentanner* or *Geizentanner*?
- M-453. Maxey Cemetery. MPC references a *Maxey Heirs Cemetery* as being at the same location as *Vestal Methodist Cemetery*. McG Map to MPC shows Maxey Heirs as being separate from (and to the north of) Vestal Methodist Cemetery. Is *Maxey Heirs* a separate section from *Vestal*? Or is *Maxey Cemetery* the same cemetery as #V-427 (*Vestal Methodist Cemetery*) Where exactly is the *Maxey* section located?

- G-459. George Clapp Cemetery. Keith was not able to find the location of this cemetery (which McG says there are no current evidence of grave). While McG book assigns this as #C-457, the McG Survey (provided to MPC) assigns this #C-459. What is the correct Survey # for *George Clapp Cemetery*?
- F-460. Louis Foust Cemetery. Is this a duplicate survey entry for #F-151? Keith is unclear regarding cemeteries #F-151 and #F-460. [Note: There are duplicate names assigned for #F-151...*Foster Chapel* and *Foust*...See notes for F-151 above]\
- J-465. Thomas Johnson Cemetery / C-465. Crenshaw Cemetery. Keith has found two different name references to the same #465 number. On the McG Survey (provided to MPC), there is a #C-465 *Crenshaw*; however the McG 2001 book assigns #J-465 to *Thomas Johnson Cemetery*.
- H-471. Hudiburgh Cemetery. What is the correct spelling, and / or valid aliases for this former cemetery: *Hudiburgh, Hudeburg, Hudiburgh*? Also, Keith's notes say that the McG 2001 book on South Knox County cemeteries gives this a # of H492. What is the correct survey #?
- F-474. Flenniken II Cemetery / Tarwater – Flenniken Cemetery. USGS and Find a Grave reference this as just *Flenniken Cemetery*. McG Book also calls this *Tarwater – Flenniken Cemetery*. Which of the names is the most proper, and which are valid aliases? FB postings of 8/2020 also refer to this as *Ferguson Cem.*
- C-493. James Miller Cemetery. Is this the same cemetery as #C470 *Cemetery (Unnamed)* that appears on the Survey list and on the Map to MPC. McG 2001 Book references this cemetery having been located on old [Baum Greenhouse property](#) near RR.
- S-512. Slatery Mountain Cemetery. Find a Grave references a *Slatery Family Cemetery*. Is this a valid alias for the *Slatery Mountain Cemetery*?
- C-904. Brown Mountain Cemetery. McG provided Keith with the name of this newly mapped cemetery in 2023. However, since this cemetery is associated with the Brown family, Keith has tagged it with an alias of *Brown Cemetery V*. Is this a valid alias?
- V-934. Valley View Missionary Baptist Church Cemetery. McG's Map identifies this as the location of Tarklin Valley Church Cemetery (#398), but the State's Cemetery database (and Property Assessor records) refers to this as the Valley View Church Cemetery. Keith assigned the Valley View name, but also tagged this cemetery with an alias of "Old Tarkiln Valley Church Cemetery (historical)". Needs verification as to whether this cemetery was in existence at the time when the old Tarkiln Valley Baptist Church was located here (see 1956-vintage USGS map). The 1961 Warranty Deed 1188 595 references the Valley View name and says land is to be used as a graveyard, implying that the land might NOT have previously been used for such said purpose.

4. Exact Location Not Verified. Keith has located the following cemeteries on the KGIS map using references / sources other than aerial photography or street-view photos. Therefore, for the following list, **Keith seeks assistance with identifying those that need correction** (or re-positioning) on the map. Keith also is seeking more exact definition of each cemetery's boundaries (as represented by a shape on the map).

Note: In reference to the cemetery names as mapped on the KGIS system, Keith uses the convention of appending the text " (historical)" to the names of those cemeteries presumed to no longer exist.

- A-3. Anderson – Ford Cemetery (historical). McG 3/1/2028 meeting identified this no longer existing cemetery as having been located near 6813 Sevierville Pike. However, McG Map shows this cemetery as having been located nearer to intersection of Sevierville Pike and E Dick Ford Ln (near [6534 E Dick Ford Ln](#)). 1960-vintage tax maps also show Anderson family as having owned parcels near the E Dick Ford Ln intersection also. Therefore, Keith has mapped the location of this cemetery to the E Dick Ford Ln location. Verification is needed.
- A-7. James Armstrong Grave. Keith positioned this on the KGIS map based upon descriptive text in McG Book. However, Keith does not know whether it has been positioned at its correct XY location.
- B-22 / O-326. Beeler – Osborne Cemetery. Keith has positioned this cemetery on the map based upon USGS map. Exact location is not discernable on aerial photography.

- B-28. Berry Cemetery (historical). McG Survey notes that this one was moved to Mt. Olive, but McG provided XY location (at [1936 Mt. Olive Rd](#)) of where the cemetery used to be during his meeting with Keith on 3/1/2018. However, McG Map to MPC places this cemetery as having been about 1000 feet south of the provided XY location south of Berry Rd. A [1976 historical pamphlet](#) produced by Lakemoor Hills Neighborhood Assoc. notes that the Berry Cemetery was located adjacent to the Berry's property (on which the old log house burned in 1972) on Berry Rd. Verification that Keith's transcribed XY location is needed.
- B-35. Biagiotti Cemetery. This cemetery is not visible via aerial photography, but is positioned on the map based upon USGS. Need verification that location on the map is correct.
- B-36. Bird Cemetery. KGIS has mapped this cemetery based upon USGS, but it is not visible on aerial photography. Need verification that location on the map is correct.
- B-41. Bookout Cemetery. Keith has mapped this one based upon proximity to USGS location, but no clear visible indication on the aerial. Where is the exact location?
- B-44. Bounds Cemetery. Lots of vegetation renders this as non-visible on aerial photography. Keith has located it based upon proximity to USGS and high ground in contours. Where is the exact location?
- B-48. Bradley – Dowell Cemetery. McG confirmed location of this cemetery, but Keith still unsure of status...Were the graves moved, or are they still possibly located at this location?
- B-52. Brooks Cemetery. Keith is unable to determine exact location of this cemetery; McG noted on 3/1/2018 that this cemetery was moved to, what Keith's notes state as, "Marble Creek". However, Keith is assuming that McGinnish might have said Marble Church Cemetery...Further confirmation needed. The McG Map to MPC places this cemetery as having been located [near the McMullan Quarry](#) (north side of the railroad). Therefore, Keith positioned its location in that same vicinity. Exact XY location is needed.
- B-56. Brown IV Cemetery. McG Book says it is off of Twin Creek Rd near John Sevier Hwy on property belonging to Hoyle Brown (1986) accessed by going thru Brown property and following old road bed into the burial plot. It may be easier to follow the old road bed fr. John Sevier as cem. Appears to be w/in 100 ft of road. McG Map shows it in vicinity of [7320 Twin Creek Rd](#). Keith's mapped location is largely a guess based upon McG map. Confirmation definitely needed for the exact location.
- C-65. Campbell Cemetery. Keith is unable to distinguish exact location from aerial photography, but has based it upon proximity to USGS map location. Where is the exact XY location and how large are the extents?
- C-66. Cardwell Cemetery. Keith is unable to discern exact XY location, but has based it upon proximity to the USGS map location. Where is the exact XY location and how large are the extents?
- C-69. Carter III Cemetery. Keith located this cemetery (which is no longer visible according to McG notes) on the map based upon proximity to USGS map location, but also upon McG descriptive text. Needs verification regarding its exact XY location.
- C-71. Unnamed Cemetery (historical). Is this perhaps in vicinity of [10023 E Emory Rd](#). McG book says loc on Emory Rd near crossing of Big Flat Creek, w/in sight of Sawyers Fort. Now plowed over and new home built on site. McG Map places it near [here](#). Keith placed it based upon McG map. Confirmation of exact location definitely needed.
- C-74. Unnamed Cemetery. McG book says on Thomas Weaver Rd near intersection w Hill Rd. 4 graves lie in fence row about 15 feet from road. Cem is about 100 yds west of the Hill Cemetery (H-194). However, from looking at the map, [Thomas Weaver Rd](#) seems to be NORTH of the Hill Cemetery. McG Map shows this being near 6110 Thomas Weaver Rd; Google Street View does seem to show some stones located underneath tree on [adjoining lot](#). Keith feels pretty confident that this is the valid location, but confirmation would be helpful.
- C-76. Unnamed Cemetery. McG book says it is located on Rutledge Pike near Ellistown intersection. On a hill to the left of the Pike as heading out of town, about 100 yds SW of [KUB substation](#). Accessed by pvt drive, the plot is about 300 yds from road. The old douglas mill was located at bottom of hill. McG Map places it close to [this location](#) near 7821 Rutledge Pike. Keith mapped this strictly on guesswork based upon McG Map and description. Confirmation of exact location definitely needed.

- C-80. Childress Cemetery (historical). McG Map places this near 2709 Long Hollow Rd, but [located way back off of the road](#). McG survey says it was located off of Brushy Valley Rd. Keith's mapped location is strictly based upon McG Map location; Verification of exact location definitely needed.
- C-88. Clark Cemetery (historical). [McG Map places this cemetery](#) approx. 1.5 straight line miles to the west of where McG and KGIS jointly placed the cemetery at their 3/1/2018 meeting ([off of Loyston Rd](#)). McG's provided map location also doesn't align with the McG Survey description that says "New Loyston Rd". Keith confirmed that the old Tax Maps show that the Clark family owned the land that is located along "New" Loyston Rd (at the location marked on the McG Map as #433 Watson Cemetery. Is it possible that the McG Map is labelled incorrectly? Keith could find no further information about Clark Cemetery in the McG books. McG confirmed that cemetery no longer visible, but Keith needs confirmation on exactly where the cemetery was located.
- C-92. Cline Cemetery. Exact location needs verified. McG provide XY location on 3/1/2018 meeting, but USGS location is significantly different. McG noted that USGS location was incorrect. Nothing visible on Aerial.
- C-93. Cobb Cemetery. Keith located this based upon USGS map, but is unsure of exact XY location. (no visible signs on aerial as to where this cemetery is located). What is the exact XY location, and extents?
- C-94. Cobb II Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon USGS map location, but vegetation obscures visible signs of cemetery on the aerial. KGIS needs confirmation of the exact XY location, and extents.
- C-95. Cobb III Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS map. Property Assessor deed also makes reference to the cemetery. However, Keith is unsure of exact XY location and extents (since it is not visible via aerial photo). Where is this exactly located?
- C-96. Collier Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS map, however is unable to discern on aerial exact location and extents of the cemetery. Verification needed.
- C-98. Colored Cemetery (historical). McG 2001 book says off of Drummer Ln near Holston River, but likely never to be located; McG suggested at the 3/1/2018 meeting that this should probably not be mapped due to its unsure location. McG map shows this as having been about 600 feet nw of a small pond, therefore KGIS has tentatively mapped this at that [similar location in clump of trees with some white visible features in the 1969 aerials](#).
- C-106. Coupland Cemetery. This cemetery was placed on the map based upon USGS, but also seems to be visible from Google Street View 2013 (albeit closer to the street than what is shown on the USGS). Property is overgrown in 2023 street view image. However, McG's survey notes say that this cemetery has disappeared. Keith needs verification as to whether his location for Coupland Cemetery is correct or not.
- C-107. Coupland II Cemetery. Keith positioned this one on the map based upon McG description only that notes its proximity to transmission tower (near [6532 Maynardville Pike](#)). Nothing visible from Street View nor aerial photography. Therefore, verification is definitely needed for its exact location and extents. The McG Map to MPC shows this cemetery being located [approx. 700 feet to the north](#) of where KGIS has positioned it.
- C-109. Cowan Cemetery. Keith positioned this based upon XY found in the GNIS (Geographic Names information system 1989) but is unable to verify its accuracy due to remoteness of site and vegetation cover...Exact location of cemetery and its extents definitely needs to be verified. McG Map to MPC seems to place this cemetery near [907 Sevier County Line Rd](#).
- C-111. Curd Cox Cemetery. Keith mapped this near [736 E Bullrun Valley Dr](#), based upon McG meeting of 3/2018, but McG was unclear at that time of exact location. The McG Map, however, shows this cemetery being located >2.5 miles away, on other side of I-75 (on [sw side of Pedigo Rd & E Bullrun Valley Dr](#) intersection.). Verification is needed of which is most exact.
- C-112. Corum Cemetery (historical). Possibly in vicinity of [1908 Lovell Rd](#) (based upon description at <https://www.wikitree.com/wiki/Corum-64>, which states that the location is on land purchased by KUB after 1992 and which now houses a natural gas facility. KUB made attempt to locate gravesites in 2008, but was unable to do so. McG 2001 book says loc off Lovell Rd abt 1/2 mi from int w Hickey Rd near Plumb Creek. 1979 poor condition, but in 1992 unable to find graves. Note that the McG Map has this cemetery on the opposite side of Lovell Rd, in the vicinity of [1811 Pinestraw Ln](#).

- C-114. Craig Cemetery. Keith mapped the location of this former cemetery based upon old USGS quad map, and viewing against old 1969 aerials, but exact position of where it used to be located cannot be discerned just from looking at the aerials. Keith then repositioned this cemetery on 2/26/2019 per McG Facebook post stating that cemetery was located behind 9308 Norlake Dr house.
- C-121. Cunningham Cemetery II. McG's survey notes say that this cemetery has disappeared. However, Property Assessor still indicates cemetery boundaries, and Keith seems to recall having read about this cemetery in a news or perhaps Shopper article. Does this cemetery still exist, or were the graves perhaps moved?
- E-134. Early Cemetery. Keith mapped this at [12245 Choto Marina Way](#) based upon USGS and inferences from McG descriptive text. Exact XY location and extents (and status) are needed. However, McG Map to MPC places this cemetery near [3006 Whispering Cove Dr](#) (which is approx. ½ mile further down the peninsula from the marina).
- E-140. Elm Grove Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS map, and Property Assessor records, but vegetation obscures this from being seen on the aerial. Need confirmation of the exact XY and extents.
- E-141. Estes Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, but is not able to confirm exact location/extents due to vegetation on the aerial photography. Need verification of exact XY and extents.
- F-147. Fletcher Cemetery (historical). McG Book 2001 says this is a re-internment cem. of old Fletcher's Church (union county) and that it may be the same as the Latham Cemetery (L234). Keith mapped the location of this cemetery near [1120 E Bullrun Valley Dr](#) based upon the McG Map to MPC, and tagged it as "historical – feature no longer there". McG confirmed in phone call of 1/19/2021 that this Fletcher cemetery had indeed been relocated back again to Pleasant View Cemetery in Union County. He also mentioned that this cemetery's original location had been "out in Powell near the Baptist Church up on the hill above that".
- F-148. Forestdale United Brethren Methodist Church Cemetery (historical). Keith mapped this as "historical – cemetery no longer there", and placed it near [3118 Brunswick St](#) based upon description in McG book of 2003. Exact location needs confirmation.
- F-150. Foster Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS. However, the McG Map to MPC shows this cemetery as being further upstream (by about 1400 feet) and nearer to the Walker- Lowe Cemetery (#430)). Need confirmation of exact location / extents.
- F-151. Foust Cemetery. Keith is not sure where this one might be located. Duplicated Survey Number Numbers 151 (with Foster Chapel) and same name as F460 (Foust). Located off of Foust Hollow Rd.
- F-154. Fraker Cemetery. Visible evidence cannot be seen from the aerial photography, although property boundaries, and USGS maps show there being a cemetery in this vicinity. (Property Assessor refers to this as *Graves Cemetery*). Keith needs verification that his mapped location is correct.
- F-155. Furewell Cemetery. Due to foliage, aerials do not show exact extents. Deeds make reference to the cemetery but don't precisely indicate its exact location.
- G-158. Garrett Cemetery. Bing StreetSide View and KGIS's Pictometry seem to show what might be headstones. However, verification of correctness of Keith's XY location would be good.
- G-160. George Mann Grave. Keith mapped this location based upon McG descriptive text, but really has not direct confirmation that his XY is correct. There does not seem to be any visible evidence from aerial or oblique photography. Keith needs to know the correct XY.
- G-164. Golden Cross Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, and upon 1950s Tax Map (which shows boundaries), but extensive vegetation obscures any visible signs. McG Book 2000 notes that until recent extension of Dante Dr, the cem was at a dead end of road? McG FB Post of 3/7/2021 says that only a four readable markers, but probably 200+/- unmarked.
- G-165. Goddard Cemetery. Keith obtained XY coordinates from McGinnis at the 3/1/2018 meeting, but is unsure whether he was correct in transcribing those. The McG map to MPC has *Goddard* located about 1.5 miles to the south of this location. Description in McG Book says this was located on old Goddard farm, on which property was an old log structure modified in the 1800's to the current form. Where was the log structure located? Keith needs confirmation that the location at 2407 Stock Creek Rd is correct.
- G-166. Good Samaritan Cemetery. Keith has located this on his map as being south of Daughters of Zion, and east of Oddfellows. Verification is needed for exact extents of this cemetery in relation to the others nearby.

- G-168. Graham Cemetery. Keith estimated the location of this based upon description of McG book and reference to Valentine line. No visible signs on aerial products due to vegetation. Exact XY location and extents needed.
- G-170. Graves Cemetery. Keith does not know exactly where this one is located due to excessive vegetation on aerial products. Exact XY and extents are needed.
- G-175. Grove Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon Property Assessor boundaries, however vegetation cover obscures exact location and extents. Where is the exact XY and extents?
- H-179. Hall III Cemetery. Keith based his mapped location upon proximity to USGS, however vegetation cover on aerial (and in Street View) obscures the cemetery. Exact XY location and extents is needed.
- H-186. Haun Cemetery. McG provided XY location at the 3/1/2018 meeting, but the value that Keith logged (near [8325 Neubert Springs Rd](#)) mismatches with McG Map to MPC (which instead shows *Haun* as being located about 1 mile further east along McCammon (near [1118 McCammon Rd](#))). Further verification needed. McG verified on 12/28/2023 that this cemetery is actually the same cemetery as Jacob Tarwater Cemetery (#399). Therefore, location of this cemetery has been resolved.
- H-184. Happy Home Cemetery. Keith has mapped this one based upon property assessor boundaries, but vegetation cover obscures exact extents. Need verification of exact geographic extents of this cemetery.
- H-195. Hill Cemetery II (historical). could this possibly have been located on parcel [047 09702](#), next to 718 E Emory Rd? McG Map to MPC shows it in this same vicinity. Confirmation needed of exact location.
- H-202. Howell – John Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS map, but definitive visible features on the aerials (due to vegetation). Keith needs the correct XY and extents.
- H-206. Hudgens Cemetery. The old 1963-vintage [Property Tax Map](#) 39 (via the Register website) show that this cemetery was located about 250 further to the SE and adjacent to the adjoining property boundary. Did the cemetery possibly get re-located to its current location, or is that old map incorrect?
- J-212. Jackson Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, but also by looking at a clump of trees on 1969 aerials. But no visible, for sure evidence seen. McG Web says “no stones”. Where is the exact XY , and what are the extents?
- J-213. Jett Cemetery. McG says this cemetery disappeared. Keith has therefore tagged it as “historical” and mapped its location based upon 1966 USGS quad map. Exact XY location and extents are needed.
- J-214. Jett II Cemetery. Keith’s mapped location of this cemetery is at the same location as the *McHaffie Cemetery* (which has a different survey #277). Is *Jett II* located in a particular section of *McHaffie*? Or is *Jett II* just another, but different, alias for the same cemetery? Clarification is needed as to whether *Jett II* should have its own separate area on the map.
- J-215. Jett III Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon description in McG book and related picture. Vegetation cover obscures any visible signs on aerial. Exact XY location needs to be verified (and extents).
- J-217. Johnson II Cemetery. McG says it has disappeared. Keith mapped the XY based upon USGS and treelines found on old 1969 aerials. Exact XY and extents of this cemetery are needed.
- J-218. Johnson III Cemetery. Keith mapped this to close proximity of USGS map location, but vegetation obscures any visible signs on aerials. Exact XY and extent verification is needed.
- J-221. Johnson VI Cemetery. Keith based the location of this one strictly on McG Book description, and therefore the XY and extents are really just an inferred guess. McG map locates it closer to [7419 Rule Rd](#). Keith needs the exact XY location and extents.
- K-224. Kain Cemetery. This cemetery was re-located to an area close to about [260 feet south](#) of the house at 7121 Old Rutledge Pike. (Facebook posts by Jerry Cunningham of 8/8/2019 shows pictures, and McG confirmed via phone call to Keith). However, the original location of the cemetery is not quite known. McG provided [an XY](#) at 3/1/2018 meeting, but visual comparison with old aerials indicate that those coordinates might not be correct. [McG map](#) shows that this cemetery had previously originally been located approx. 500 feet north of the identified location. McG Book goes on to say that this grave was located next to switching house in fenced area in 1977, but no longer there in 1999. KGIS area of 1969 shows a long structure, with [a rectangular area adjacent](#)..could this possibly have been the location? Confirmation of the original location is needed.

- K-225. Kain II Cemetery (historical). McG Survey notes says disappeared. McG Book 2001 says off Drummer Ln in copse of trees overlooking Holston R on Ideal Cement Co land adj to Trafalgar plantation. Unmarked. Keith doesn't really have a good idea...could it have been located on parcel [061 00801](#) on S side of River???
- K-228. Kidd Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon fence line location and McG descriptive text. Also, the Find A Grave coordinate was nearby. Highly vegetated areas precludes any visible identification on the aerals. Need specific XY location, and extents.
- K-231. Koontz Cemetery (historical). McG noted at 3/1/2018 meeting that this is alias of McCloud Cemetery (#275)...however, McG book description says this was located on Hill Rd between York and Holbert intersections, which is pretty far away from McCloud. McG map to MPC also places this cemetery in vicinity of [8505 Hill Rd](#). Keith seeks clarification from McG to make sure that this is same cemetery as McCloud (#M275) or whether a different cemetery altogether. Verification of location and status is needed.
- L-235. Lay Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon inferences from McG's book description. Exact XY location is needed. (Also, Keith tagged this one as historical, since the graves were moved to Greenwood).
- L-239. Legg Cemetery. Keith mapped this one solely based upon description in McG book that says it was located 100 yrds to rear of the house. Exact XY is needed, along with extents. McG Map to MPC shows it also as being in this same vicinity.
- L-240. Legg – England Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon property boundary location, and inference of a small copse of trees in the middle of what looks to be a junkyard. Is Keith's mapped XY and extent correct?
- L-245. Lonas Cemetery III (Jacob) (historical). Keith mapped it based upon the McG Map to MPC, and book description, Keith positioned this near [6621 Nightingale Ln](#). Verification is needed of exact location.
- L-246. Long Cemetery. This cemetery is mapped by the Property Assessor as an unnamed cemetery, but is clearly seen via Street View. Based upon McG description, Keith is assuming that this is the same as McG's *Long Cemetery*. Verification that Keith has assigned the correct name is needed.
- L-249. Lonsdale Cemetery. Keith mapped this one by the boundaries of the Property Assessor; vegetation obscures actual extents. Need verification of action extent/coverage.
- L-251. Lowe Cemetery. Keith [mapped this based](#) upon McG provision of XY at 3/1/2018 meeting, but no visible means of identification on aerial or Google Street View. However, McG Map to MPC instead places this a little further to the west (by about 1200 feet, near [3343 McCurry Way](#)). McG book also says this is on McAnally ridge and accessible only via foot (1987), but the XY locations by McG (at meeting and on map) are not actually on the main ridge, but instead on a small ridge south of the main McAnally Ridge. Need confirmation on exact XY location. Further Note: the George Clapp Cemetery (#G459) is also supposedly on this same small ridge based upon the McG map to MPC, but to the northeast of the XY provided by McG on 3/1.
- L-252. Luttrell Cemetery. Keith mapped it based upon USGS and cluster of trees visible on aerial. Needs confirmation that XY and extents are correct.
- L-253. Luttrell Cemetery II. Keith mapped this at [Carter Elementary](#) based upon XY provided by McG at 3/1/2018 meeting. However, McG map only shows a small black dot at this location, but instead shows Luttrell II as being located about 1.5 miles to the west, [near Straw Plains & Wooddale intersection](#). Verification of exact location needed.
- M-257. Major Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS but also possibly visible stones in aerial photography. Need confirmation that XY is correct.
- M-258. Maloney Cemetery (historical). Keith placed this near [3517 Timberlake Dr](#) based upon McG Map to MPC location. McG says it was formerly on the Maloney farm near Timberlake Dr. removed about 1948 to Mt Olive Cem. Exact Location needs verification.
- M-259. Marble Hill Church of God Cemetery. McG notes that the original *Marble Hill Cemetery* was moved here in 1980. Keith assumes that the original location of that *Marble Hill Cemetery* was [at the location](#) as marked on the USGS 1953 map (and labeled as Cemetery).
- M-262. Maxwell Cemetery. Property Assessor records indicate cemetery is located here, but aerals do not show visible confirmation. Please confirm XY and extents.

- M-270 McCall Cemetery / C-62 Cabbage Cemetery. These are in very close proximity to one another on KGIS's map, where Keith re-positioned them based upon locations provided by McGinnis at 3/1/2018 meeting. However, McG Map to MPC shows McCall as having been located on the north side of Cabbage Rd (near [4323 Cabbage Dr](#)), about 2000 feet away from the XY location provided by McG at the meeting. Keith needs confirmation that the currently placed location near [4215 Kingdom Ln](#) is correct.
- M-274. McCarrell Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, but also inferences from McG descriptive text. Looks as though some of the stones can be seen from Pictometry photography. Probably needs verification, however for Exact XY and extents.
- M-279. McMillan II Cemetery. Keith mapped it based upon USGS, but aerials do not confirm yes or no. Need verification of exact XY and extents.
- M-280 McNutt Cemetery. Keith mapped based upon USGS, but adjusted to visible white point features on 2022 aerials (which might be headstones) at top of knoll. Very vegetated area, so exact XY and extents are needed.
- M-281. Meadowlawn Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon large footprint on the USGS map, but there does not seem to be any physical evidence on the current aerials. While Keith feels pretty confident about the XY, he needs to know full geographic extents of this cemetery.
- M-286. Mitchell (Joshua Mitchell) Cemetery (historical). McG Survey notes that this cemetery is disappeared. Could this possibly have been located near [3009 Sunny Creek Way](#)? McG Map to MPC places it somewhere near this location. McG 2000 Book calls this Joshua Mitchell. Keith mapped it based upon the McG Map. Verification of exact position needed.
- M-289. Moulden Cemetery. Keith mapped based upon USGS location, however vegetation covers and visible evidence from the aerials. Keith needs exact XY and extents.
- N-304. Nelson Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, but is unable to see any visible evidence regarding exact location on the aerials due to vegetative cover. Exact XY and extents needed.
- O-327. Owens Cemetery. Keith located this solely based upon written description of McG, but can see no physical evidence on aerials or street view to verify that his location is correct. USGS does not show this cemetery. McG Map to MPC shows this as being about 500 feet more to the NW of the [KGIS Location](#). Exact XY and Extents are definitely needed for this one.
- O-319. Old Crestview (Black) Cemetery. Keith has assumed that this is just an alias for [Crestview](#) Cemetery (see #116). Is there perhaps a particular section of Crestview that should be mapped as Old Crestview? Keith seeks clarification.
- P-331. Parker III Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon USGS, but exact XY and Extents are not known. Keith is unable to see any physical evidence on aerials due to vegetation cover. Exact XY and extents of cemetery are needed.
- P-334. Perry Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon USGS, and what looks to be a small visible section of vegetation in the corner of an open field. But otherwise, no visible evidence of correct position. XY coordinates, and extents of cemetery are needed.
- P-335. Pest House Cemetery. Keith positioned this one based upon 2014?? City-conducted study of the graves on the west side of Proctor. However, for the section to the east of Proctor, Keith relied solely upon inferences from McG descriptive text. Therefore, XY coordinates and extents are needed primarily for that eastern section.
- P-336. Phibbs Cemetery. Keith based his location upon XY coordinates from USGS, and an individual (Mr. Tipton) called on Oct 24, 2018 and verbally confirmed location, But aerial does not confirm. Exact XY and extents of cemetery are still desired.
- R-346. Reed II Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, but based upon aerials, this cemetery seems to be no longer there. Keith needs correct XY Location and extents, along with status as to whether this cemetery was moved, etc.
- R-348. Reynolds Cemetery (historical). Keith has mapped the former location of this cemetery based solely upon McG descriptive notes. Therefore, exact location XY and extents needed. McG Map to MPC has it located approx. 1200 feet further to the northeast from where Keith mapped it.

- R-349. Rhea Cemetery. Keith has mapped this based upon USGS, but can't see visible confirmation on aerials. Exact XY and extents are needed.
- R-359. Rutherford Cemetery (historical). McG Survey says "disappeared". McG 2000 Book says was located in a field halfway betw Rodgers Rd and Jim Wolfe Rd , [1/4 mi from Rockydale Cem.](#) McG Map to MPC places this cemetery near parcel "[014 003](#)" of 8616 Clement Rd. Keith placed it on this parcel, but exact Location needs verification.
- S-362. Saylor Cemetery (historical). McG Survey says graves moved to Lynnhurst. Could this have been located at [1252 Saylor's Ford Rd](#)? or better yet near [1305 Fish Trap Ln](#)? McG Map to MPC (and McG Notes) note that this cemetery was located on "Saylor's Ford Rd", but current MPC maps shows this same street segment as now being called "Fish Trap Ln". McG notes say it was located " about 200 yards from the roads dead end into the Holston R. It was on the front lawn of the pre-civil war Saylor Family home. Keith's [mapped location](#) needs to verification.
- S-363. Scott Cemetery (historical). McG Survey says this cem. is Disappeared. McG book says this was located in Windmere Estates on Scott Ln, but should probably have instead stated "Windfield Estates". McG Map places this as having been near [2134 Scott Ln.](#) Keith has mapped it there also, but needs confirmation of exact location.
- S-364. Second Presbyterian Church Cemetery (historical). Keith based his map location of this former cemetery upon various references in McClung digital photos, etc. Confirmation that his mapped XY is correct would be good.
- S-365. Sellers Cemetery. McG provided XY at 3/1/2018 meeting, but that XY disagrees significantly with the McG Map to MPC, which places this cemetery about 3 miles away. Verification needed as to exact location.
- S-370. Shelton Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS proximity, but is unsure of validity and of the extents. Exact XY and extents are needed.
- S-371. Shelton Cemeter II (historical). Keith mapped this in vicinity of 8233 Shelton Rd, based upon loose description of McG book, which says that says it was about 30 ft from road on fence line in an open field. The MPC Map to MPC also places it near this location. Exact location is needed.
- S-375. Shipe Cemetery III. [Keith mapped this based](#) upon USGS, but vegetation in the area precludes any definitive location. McG also notes that visible signs of the marker and/or gravestones at this cemetery were no longer there in 1990. McG FB post of 9/15/2020 confirms that this cemetery still exists. Exact XY and extents are needed by KGIS. McG Map to MPC actually placed this cemetery as being [about 2000 feet north](#) of Keith's (and USGS's) location. McG FB post also says that this cemetery was formerly called the Lusby Cemetery.
- S-377. Shook Cemetery. Keith has mapped this based upon USGS, but also what appears to be grave markers or stumps in the Pictometry oblique photography, Bing StreetSide photos. Verification is needed regarding XY and extents.
- S-379. Slave Cemetery. Keith mapped this solely based upon USGS quad map. Excessive vegetation does not allow for identification of exact position. XY location and extents are needed. (Note: Keith has labeled this cemetery as *Sevier Yards Slave Cemetery.*)
- S-381. Slave Cemetery (historical). Keith has positioned this based upon USGS mapped feature. Exact Location and extents are needed. FB discussion of Jan. 1, 2023 in the Knoxville History & Memories group noted that this was probably NOT a slave cemetery as indicated on the USGS map, and that the cemetery is most likely no longer there (there having only been a couple of empty ground vaults inventoried back my McG in 1978). Keith has tagged this cemetery as "historical".
- S-386. Spangler Cemetery. McG Map shows this much further (~1.3 miles) south ([near 8943 Henry Hollow Way](#)) of the location that was provided at the 3/1/2018 meeting (which is [adjacent to what looks to be an old log home](#)). McG book description also notes that this cemetery was within site of old Klondike School (8808 Spangler Rd). Verification of exact location (and status) is needed. Notes: McG Web also says that this cemetery is "Not Found".
- S-383. Smoker Cemetery (historical). McG Survey says graves were moved to Concord Mennonite. McG noted that this was at location of Karns gym. Keith needs clarification of which gym. Was it on the site of the old 1938 Karns High School? (<https://www.knoxschools.org/domain/1733>). Keith positioned the location based

- upon structures in the 1959 aerial. Needs clarification regarding correct location. Note: the McG Map to MPC actually places this cemetery as having been further north, [near 8117 Beaver Ridge Rd](#).
- S-387. Spitzer Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, and rough alignment with parcel boundaries. But exact XY verification is needed, along with extents.
- S-393. Stinnett Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon descriptive notes in McG, and has classified is as “historical” since the graves were supposedly moved. (Deed makes reference to a cemetery easement). Exact XY location is needed.
- T-398. Tarklin Valley Baptist Cemetery. McG Web places this on Jett Rd, and KGIS has mapped this cemetery at 8827 Jett Rd, site of the Tarklin Valley Missionary Baptist Church. However, McG Map to MPC places this cemetery 2 miles further to the NE, at the location of the current Valley View Baptist (and former location of Tarklin Valley Baptist). Confirmation is needed to correct location.
- T-399. Jacob Tarwater Cemetery. 2006 Deed Reference for parcel at 8418 Bud King Ln identifies location of the cemetery, but it cannot be seen on the aerials. Confirmation needed re: it’s correct location.
- T-414. Troutt Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon Property Assessor boundaries. However gravestones and exact extents are not discernable on aerials due to vegetation. Need confirmation that XY and extents are correct.
- W-430. Walker II – Lowe Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS, but visible evidence on aerial cannot be seen due to vegetation. Exact XY and extents are needed.
- W-431. Wallace Cemetery. Keith’s mapped location is based upon USGS. Vegetation obscures discernment of exact extents. Exact XY location and extents needed.
- W-442. Woods Cemetery. Keith mapped this one based upon proximity to USGS, but also on descriptive text in McG book. USGS map location places this cemetery on roughly the same spot as the built structure about 100 feet to the west of where Keith has positioned it. Exact XY location is needed, and extents, along with status as to whether this cemetery is still intact.
- Y-445. York Cemetery. Keith wrote down an incorrect house number (5325 Salem Church Rd) during the 3/1/2018 meeting with McGinnis. Needs followup to find out exact XY. McG Map to MPC places this cemetery [near 5607 Salem Church Rd](#), about 1 mile from Daniels Rd intersection. However, book says that it was ¼ mile NW of Daniels rd intersection, which is near the location of 5325 if that house number actually existed. Need verification of exact location. Keith placed it near 5349 Salem Church Rd ([link](#)).
- Y-446. York II Cemetery. Keith has mapped this one solely based upon descriptive text in McG book, and in reference to old barn location. Therefore, confirmation is needed for the exact XY and extents.
- B-452. Barbara Hill Cemetery. McG notes that this cemetery was moved. Keith mapped the location of its former location as just a guess (underneath Ayres Hall)...Exact XY Location is needed of where this cemetery was located. Is Barbara Blount Hall Cemetery (KGIS #901) the same as this “Barbara Hill” Cemetery, or were they two separate ones?
- M-453. Maxey Heirs Cemetery. McG map to MPC shows *Maxey Heirs* as being separate from (and to the north of) the adjacent *Vestal Church* cemetery. Where exactly are the extents of *Maxey Heirs*? (aerials do no make it clear).
- C-458. Cemetery. Keith mapped this cemetery as *Unnamed Cemetery* based upon the USGS map location. (it’s located close to the formerly named Bowman Rd in South Knox County). However, vegetation on the aerial makes it difficult to determine whether signs of the graveyard still exist. Exact XY location is needed, and extents. McG Map to MPC confirms this as being in the same vicinity.
- C-462. Unnamed Cemetery. USGS locates this cemetery approx. 1000 feet to the east of where McG’s Map to MPC places this cemetery. Exact Location needs verification.
- S-462. Unnamed (Slave) Cemetery. See note about S-462 in Section A above. This survey number is a duplicate with the C-462. Keith has not mapped this cemetery due to uncertainty regarding its location. Possibly in vicinity of 1709 Bickerstaff Blvd?
- J-465. Thomas Johnson Cemetery / C-465 Crenshaw Cemetery. Keith mapped this one solely upon descriptive text of McG book, which references property owner of Keener (which Keith assumes is at 1904 Crenshaw Rd). However, McG map to MPC actually shows this cemetery as being located in back yard (hillside) of

- 6534 Crescent Dr. Keith needs exact XY location and extents for this cemetery (along with the correct cemetery name)
- H-471. Hudiburgh Cemetery. Keith mapped this former cemetery based upon McG descriptive text. Exact XY Location is therefore needed. McG notes that the location was near the former Copelands Restaurant (6400 Kingston Pike) within viewing distance of Central Baptist. Jack Neely's Bearden history book (2022) however notes that the Hudeburg house was located adjacent to Bearden Elementary. Further investigation needed as to the location.
- F-474. Flenniken II Cemetery / Tarwater – Flenniken Cemetery. Keith mapped this former cemetery based upon USGS position. Exact XY is needed.
- B-489 (or B-480). William Brown Cemetery. McG's Map to MPC does not reference this cemetery, but there is a "black dot" in the vicinity of 7301 Palmyra Dr (on n. bank of Beaver Creek). McG provided an XY at the 3/1/2018 meeting locating this cemetery at [5021 Crippen Rd](#). McG FB post of 7/27/2020 reconfirmed that that this cemetery located on Crippen Rd and that there are no readable stones.
- M-493. James Miller Cemetery (historical). McG 2001 Book references this cemetery having been located on old [Baum Greenhouse property](#) near RR. McG's Map to MPC only shows the #C470 (unknown cemetery) in this vicinity. Is the James Miller cemetery perhaps the same as that Unknown one (#470)? Keith has tentatively mapped this cemetery as having been located near [HERE](#) near 6431 Baum Dr. Need verification regarding name and exact location.
- H-496. Christopher Hanby Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon McG descriptive text, but is unable to discern for sure (from Street View, etc.) exact location. Exact XY location is needed.
- N-507. Norman Cemetery. Keith mapped this based upon USGS map, but is unable to discern from aerials visible signs of the cemetery. (Note: this cemetery actually seems to be located in Anderson County instead of Knox.) Keith need exact XY location and extents.
- S-512. Slatery Mountain Cemetery. Keith mapped this based solely upon inference from McG descriptive text, but no visible signs on aerials. (Keith also needs a status update as to whether this cemetery still exists or not). Exact XY location and extents are needed.
- L-914. Larew Cemetery (historical). This cemetery was not assigned a Survey Number on McG's Survey list, so Keith has assigned it a temp. #914. The McG book on 1st and 2nd District cemeteries makes reference (and describes the location) of this "no longer there" cemetery in its discussion about the nearby Claiborne Cemetery. The McG Map to MPC shows an unlabeled cemetery (see Unlabeled #12 in Section B) in the vicinity of [4004 Audubon Dr](#) (in NE corner of Tazewell/Briercliff intersection). Keith has mapped it here, but exact location needs verification.
- B-912. Joseph Bell Cemetery (historical). This cemetery was not assigned a Number on McG's Survey, so Keith has assigned it a temporary #B912. McG 2017 book discusses this cemetery, but Keith does not know quite where to map it. For now, Keith has mapped it near [1928 McCalla Ave](#)? Is this possibly related to Woods II or Burnett Cemeteries located also along McCalla? Exact Location is needed.
- J-916. Robert Johnson Cemetery. This was a newly added cemetery (in 2018) based upon McG provision of XY location. However, McG FB post of 9/2021 slightly disagrees from the provided XY location; post says that cemetery was located at the top of the hill next to a cantilever barn. Verification of exact locale is needed.
- U-928. Unnamed Slave Cemetery (historical). [National Register application](#) for the Alexander Bishop House makes note of a nearby cemetery, and McG indicated in FB posting of 12/13/2021 that slave cemetery possibly existed at this location. However, an archeological survey conducted in 2022 found no evidence of existing graves. Therefore, unsure of location of the slave cemetery referenced by McG FB posting. (Compare this cemetery with nearby former location of the Curd Cemetery (C-122)).
- L-931. Lane Family Cemetery. Find a Grave references this, but with no mapped location. On 12/13/23 McG identified this as being located on ridge to the back of 1731 Richard Ln. Keith mapped this to a ridge top location near that address, but verification of exact spot is needed.
